Advancing beyond First Class requires a dedicated commitment to your fellow Scouts and the success of the troop. Holding a leadership position is a privilege that carries specific responsibilities.

Beyond First Class rank up to the Eagle rank, a Scout must make a commitment to her fellow Scouts and the Troop to be a leader. A Scout's service in a leadership position is a privilege and is accepted on the terms of the following Agreement:
